

ODE TO BILLIE JOE

Played fingerstyle, the thumb picking the bass note of the chords before an upstroke with the other fingers, keeping the rhythm clipped, and syncopated.

In live performances Bobbie always plays the change to Am7, but on the original record she sometimes skips it, and just stays on the D9 to D9/A riff. I've put those Am7 chords in brackets, so you can choose to play them or not.

D9 = x54550 **G7** = 3x343x or 3x34xx (without the 5th)
D9/A = x54530 **C7** = x32310
Am7 = 505550 **D7** = x5453x
