

THE CHAIN (w/ live ending)
FLEETWOOD MAC

[Intro] 4 count-in kick drums

**Em (variations, hammer-ons, pull offs, etc. add 3rd fret, string 1, etc etc)
(8 riffs, 16 measures, ending in run-down from e string to A)
(listen for ONE COWBELL HIT, CUE SINGING)**

[Verse 1]

Em **A**
Listen to the wind blow
D5 C5 Em (**or use root chords for D and C**)
Watch the sun rise
A
Run in the shadows
D5 C5 Em
Damn your love Damn your lies

[Chorus] X2

[Pre-Verse] 4 Em riffs, 3rd and 4th with kick, ending in run-down from e string to A

[Verse 2]

[Pre-Break] and drums

Em (as in beginning)

(listen for bass riffs) READ !!!!!!!

.After ^{2nd} bass riff, The guitar fades in with increasing volume, play the High E string, alternate with high E octave on e string for TWO MORE BASS RIFFS, total of FOUR.

[Break]

THEN FOUR MORE BASS RIFFS FOR SOLOING in HIGH E OCTAVES, over
Am Em

[OUTRO CHORUS] X4 THEN ABRUPT ENDING
